Should emergency treatment for my child be necessary, I authorize a leader representative of Whitefish Assembly to act on my behalf, provided a reasonable effort has been made to reach me and approve appropriate treatment. I know that all insurance is carried by my own personal insurance as primary. I give Whitefish Assembly permission to use photos of my child/teen in promotional materials, printed or electronic.

I also give permission for WFA staff and volunteers to have my student cell phone number, if given by the student, text my teen about group events, and for personal encouragement.

I also give permission for my child(ren)/teenager to ride the Whitefish Assembly van or bus on Wednesday nights for special events or, if I live in the Forest Acres Neighborhood, from Forest Acres to Whitefish Assembly and back at the end of the night. I release Whitefish Assembly and all leaders or church staff from all liability. I understand and will help my child follow the expectations and action steps listed below.

BUS BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS:

Following the mindset of respect and encouragement, we ask all bus riders to respect the bus and the leaders that are taking their time to transport the group. We ask that all riders take a seat and stay in it, keep their voices at a conversation level, pick up their garbage, get off the bus at their own house (unless they have written permission from a parent), and follow directions given by the leaders.

ACTION STEPS:

Step 1: Verbal warning, asking the student to discontinue the inappropriate behavior

Step 2: Verbal warning and moving the student to the front of the bus.

Step 3: Parents are contacted.

Step 4: If behavior continues, student must either have a ride to church or a parent can ride the bus with the student.
